A deep golden ale with a full malty flavour and lasting French countryside aroma.

Triple Champion 4.0% 

A full-bodied rich ale, deep chestnut in colour with a lasting malty backtaste.

A bitter sweet Sussex Best Bitter. Fruity, round and thirst-quenching.

Dry hopped with Amarillo and Chinook for colour with a lasting grapefruit and tangerine.



Aurora 4.8% 

US hops give a resinous mouthfeel with big citrus and tropical fruit flavours.

Pale gold in colour, with a crisp malt edge and sharp bitterness.

IPA 5.0% 

Flavours of marmalade on toast with the delicate sweetness of honey and pine.


Plum Porter 4.5% 

A brand new fruity Porter from this award-winning brewery.


Session Pale Ale 3.8% 

Light honeyed sweetness leaving a crisp punch and a dry, clean finish.

Gold 4.8% 

Premium gold-coloured Bitter with refreshing hints of elderflower.

Old Town Tom 4.5% 

Light-coloured craft beer infused with ginger and a hint of lemon.

Chummy Bluster 4.4% 

Made with no fewer than seven malts and three different English hops.


Parabellum Milk Stout 4.1% 

Dark and delicious, a rich jet-black Milk Stout.


Zamzama 6.5% 

Rounded malt body meets an avalanche of hops, with mango, lychee and grapefruit.

Armada Ale 4.5% 


A Golden Ale with vibrant hop tones and a dry finish.

Old Ale 4.3% 


Soft and full-bodied, with hints of dried fruits and dates.

Olympia 4.8% 


A refreshing and light Golden Ale with a soft bitterness. A hoppy summer favourite.

Prince of Denmark 7.5% 

A complex beer with aromas of leather, chocolate and liquorice.


Star of Eastbourne 5.5% 

This golden IPA exudes a full hop aroma, with subtle hints of marmalade.

Sussex Best Bitter 4.0% 

A blend of four different hops impart a distinctive character and moreish quality.

Black Cherry Mild 4.2% 

A full fruit and flavoursome Dark Mild.


Chennai IPA 5.0% 

Notes of sweet oranges, grapefruit, lemons, resin and pine.

Powder Blue 5.5% 

Subtle blueberry and raisin notes with a gentle gathering bitterness.

American Red 4.8% 

Caramel malt character, rich, smooth, with spiced stone fruit flavours.


English Pale Ale 4.2% 

Loaded with English Cascade and Ernest hops, dry hopped for an aromatic finish.

Arapaho 4.9% 

Generously-hopped APA with notes of bitter apricot and passion fruit.


Hip Hop 4.0% 

Clean and crisp pale malt flavour, with a pleasing dry and bitter finish.

Special Ale 4.6% 

Russet Brown Ale with roasted and toasted malted notes on the nose.


Tail Wagger 4.1% 

A deep ochre Pale Ale with a satisfying lasting finish.


Long Man

Best Bitter 4.0% 

Well balanced, complex bitter sweet malty taste and fragrant hops.

Oatmeal Stout 4.4% 

In the style of a traditional London Stout, with notes of coffee and chocolate.


Old Man 4.3% 

Full, rich tasting, dark beer with soft malt notes of coffee and chocolate.

Rising Giant 4.8% 

Triple hopped, with a pleasant citrus fruit aroma and robust bitterness.

A classic American Pale Ale. Super smooth, fruit-filled, a session-first.


Yacht Rock 3.8% 

Extra Pale Ale. No dry hops, no haziness, just citrus-fuelled chill.

Boadicea 4.5% 

A straw-coloured beer brewed with 100% Boadicea hops.

Ebulem 4.5% 

This superb Porter combines elderberries with black and chocolate malts.

Blood Orange Pale 4.9% 

Real blood orange peel brings juicy, yet finely balanced flavours.

India Pale Ale 5.0% 

Packed full of New World hops, this IPA is bursting with tropical and citrus fruit.

Three Legs

Mosaic Pale 4.5% 

A single-hopped Pale with a melon and floral aroma, and solid pale malt backbone.

Pale #3 3.7%

Low ABV and bitterness with big Columbus and Cascade hop additions for lots of aroma.

Blue Sky Drinking 4.4%

Well balanced tawny Best Bitter with a full-bodied malty backbone and a delicate citrus finish.

Smokescreen 5.5%

Robust smoked Porter brewed with seven different grains and finished with all English hops.

Atom Brewing

Principia 5.5%

A bold and fruity malt profile waltzes with classic English hops in this traditional Bitter.

Bad Seed

Code of Silence 5.5%

A West Coast IPA with Lemondrop and Loral hops.

Light Cluster 4.6%

In-your-face American Pale Ale hopped with Citra, Centennial and Bravo.

Brass Castle

Rocky Road 2.8%

Featuring a marshmallowy sweetness, smooth chocolate and a delicate biscuity malt.

Bristol Beer Factory

Fortitude 4.0%

Smooth, balanced, moreish. Three words that any Amber Ale should scream from the brewery roof.

Milk Stout 4.5%

Smooth chocolate sweetness, balanced with notes of coffee and stone fruit.

Party Wave 4.2%

An Aussie dual-hop session brew with lychee, mandarin orange, citrus peel and slight clove spice.

Buxton

Buxton Best 4.2%

A classic Best Bitter, hopped with Fuggles and Goldings, featuring a robust malt backbone and a pleasingly bitter sweet finish.

Dark Revolution

Velveteen 4.8%

Chocolate Milk Stout. Silky smooth oats, cacao nibs and sugar come together to generate a deliciously drinkable Milk Stout.

Farm Yard

Chaff 4.7%

A New England inspired session IPA that brings bags of tropical and citrus fruits on the palate with a floral aroma.

Fell

Foss 3.4%

A typical English session Pale Ale.

Mallinsons

Citra 3.8%

Grapefruit and light mango nose, with a bitter hoppy citrus taste, and a grapefruit and light passion fruit finish.

Marble

Manchester Bitter 4.2%

Speciality malt gives the deep golden colour and robust base, balanced by crisp bitterness and a floral, lemony aroma.

Stout 5.7%

Roasty and robust. It is deep, dark and rich, with layers of malty complexity.

Neptune

Waterfall Dawn 5.1%

An IPA brewed using Citra, Simcoe and Ekuanot hops.

Nightjar

Kaleidoscope World 4.0%

Clean and crisp citrus notes with gooseberries and a hint of mango.

Kokopelli 4.6%

Refreshing Amber Ale with subtle hints of over-ripe strawberries, honeydew melon and apricot.

Northern Whisper

Blimey 3.8%

An excessively dry-hopped session IPA, with a strong grapefruit aroma.

Oppenchops 4.0%

An ultra pale, refreshing session IPA hopped with Ella, Galaxy and Melba.

Oakham

Asylum 4.5%

An amber coloured, American-style hopped Premium Bitter with hop aromas of grapefruit and berry.

Citra 4.2%

Light gold in colour, bursting with citrus and tropical hop flavours.

Pig and Porter

Red Spider Rye 4.8%

A ruby Red Ale made with rye malt and Centennial and Columbus hops.

Stone Free 4.2%

Chinook, Mosaic and Simcoe hops impart fruit forward flavours.

Pomona Island

Cruffatin 4.1%

Malty and bitter. How it should be.

Dr Worm 4.1%

Fun and fruity, with a peachy, tropical dry hop of Mosaic, Pacifica, Chinook and El Dorado.

Quantock

Wills Neck 4.3%

A late-hopped Golden Ale with Chinook and Cascade hops.

Redemption

Hopspur 4.5%

Amber Ale with citrus fruit aromas and biscuity malt flavours.

Rock the Kazbek 4.0%

Single-hopped Blonde Ale with Czech Kazbek hops for refreshing zesty lemon, lime and grapefruit flavours.

Trinity 3.0%

Generous late hopping provides Seville orange aromas.

Roosters

Capability Brown 4.0%

A classic Best Bitter, deep amber in colour.

Highway 51 3.7%

Sessionable Pale Ale that is backed up by a hint of citrus and a grapefruit finish.

London Thunder 4.2%

Roasted malt and chocolate flavours are abundant in this smooth, dark Porter.

Throwback 5.3%

A vintage stock ale brewed using Goldings hops, brown malt and muscovado sugar.

Salopian

Golden Thread 5.0%

A bright gold ale, using wheat, lager malt, and flavoured with an infusion of aroma hops.

Oracle 4.0%

A crisp, sparkling sunflower gold ale with a striking hop profile. Dry and refreshing with a long citrus aromatic finish.

Saltaire

Saltaire Blonde 4.0%

Light and refreshing, this signature Blonde Ale balances soft malt flavours with subtle spice from Bohemian Saaz hops.

Triple Choc 4.8%

Internationally acclaimed, this moreish dark beer complements English Fuggle hops with rich chocolate decadence.

Stroud

Budding 4.5%

Aromatic citrus notes from Amarillo hops harmonise with a sweet malt backbone.

Lord Marples 4.0% ■

A deep mahogany ale with flavours of honey and caramel.

Market Porter 4.5% ■

A creamy, rich Porter with a floral hop flavour and mild roast coffee aftertaste.

Twisted Barrel

Dream Variations 4.0% ■

Slightly tart juiciness without being chewy and sweet.

Twisted Oak

Code Red 4.3% ■

A vegan ruby IPA brewed from 100% renewable energy using traditional methods.

Fallen Tree 3.8% ■

A modern style Amber session ale. Smooth tasting with toffee notes and lemon and orange on the nose.

Twisted Wheel

Moral Panic 4.2% ■

A tropical and zesty punch with subtle aromas of mango, lychee and citrus.

You Didn't Have To Be So Nice 5.5% ■

Smooth, easy-drinking dark Stout, with the addition of chocolate for a sweet finish.

Verdant

I Remember Having One 3.8% ■

Soft Cornish water and Citra hops makes this a smooth, surprisingly big-bodied and zesty little beer.

Ideation 4.0% ■

Bitter and citrus flavours, featuring grapefruit, passion fruit and a hint of tangerine.

A heavily-hopped Pale Ale with Azacca and Mosaic hops, to bring flavours of stone fruits and a pleasing bitterness.

Organic, award-winning, vegan-friendly.

The oldest established producer in the UK, over 300 years old.

Gwatkins

Stoke Red Cider 6.0% (Medium/Dry)

Highly popular, full-bodied and rounded.

Haywood Farm Medium Cider 6.0% (Medium)

Lovely summery glass of Cornish sunshine.

Crisp, acidic cider with elderflower overtones.
